 - Continuing Political Committees \$8,200 per election

- State law prohibits EFO Troy E. Singleton for Assembly from accepting contributions from banks, insurance companies, public utilities, cable television companies, and any majority shareholder in such entities.
- State law (The Casino Control Act) prohibits EFO Troy E. Singleton for Assembly from accepting contributions from companies that hold or are applicants for a casino license, including any holding company or subsidiary of a casino licensee or applicant. Contributions from officers, directors, key employees of any such company are prohibited. In addition, contributions by members of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission and its employees are barred.
